Lunch provided.

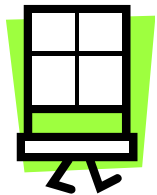

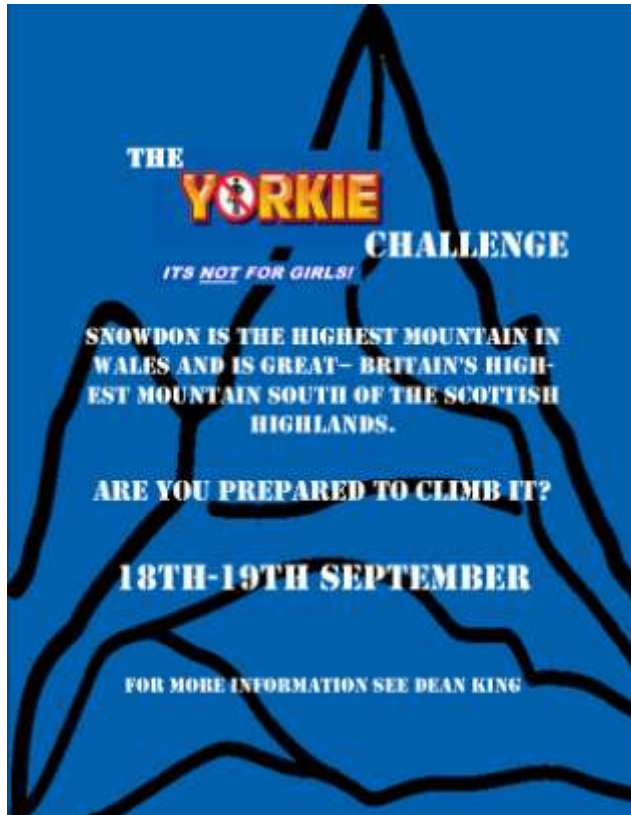

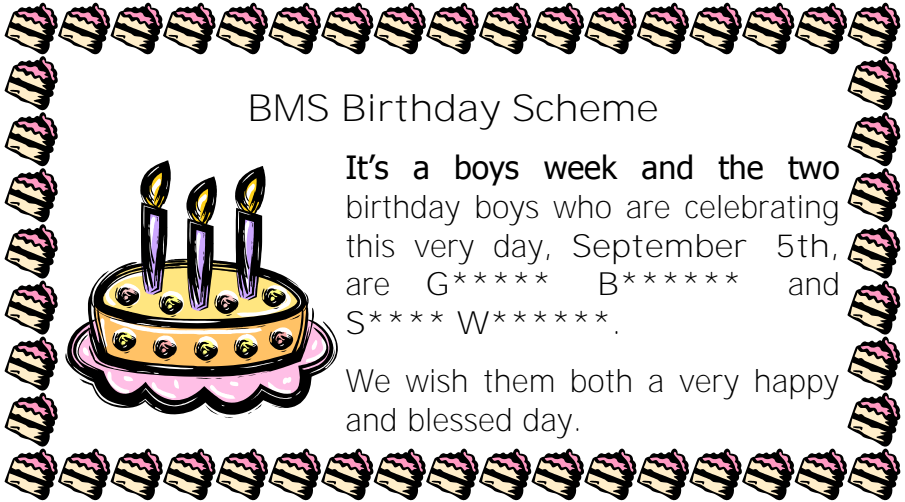
